It is a constituent unit of the National Council of Educational Research and Training (NCERT), established in 1993 by the Ministry of Education (MoE), Government of India. It is also a UNESCO-UNEVOC (International Project on Technical and Vocational Education) Network Centre in India. The Institute has a picturesque 35-acre campus with Departments created for different disciplines, viz. Agriculture and Animal Husbandry, Business & Commerce, Engineering & Technology, Health and Paramedical Sciences, Home Science and Hospitality Management and Humanities, Science, Education & Research.

The Institute conducts research, development and training programmes and extension on vocational and pre-vocational education and wide array of disciplines for the key functionaries a and teachers. The highly qualified team of the Institute possesses excellent professional skills and experience required to impart training for classroom teaching and training.

The Institute has traversed the path of rapid development in vocational education, responding positively to the changing needs of the industry and at times initiating significant changes in the field of vocational education. The evolution of the Institute in the last 30 years has witnessed various challenges, but these have served as opportunities to explore new horizons and work on possibilities of reimagining vocational education in light of NEP 2020 for meeting the skill needs of the people at the local and global canvas.

### **Major Activities of PSSCIVE**



### **Departments and Centres**

The PSS Central Institute of Vocational Education has the following Departments and Centres:

#### 1. Agriculture and Animal Husbandry

Agriculture is the most important sector in Indian economy, as it is not only the mainstay for food security but also provide livelihood to about 52% of the working population in India. In order to fulfil the need of skilled para-professionals in agriculture and allied sectors, the Department of Agriculture and Animal Husbandry has been involved in designing and developing vocational courses and teaching-learning materials in different areas of agriculture and allied sectors under the National Skill Qualification Framework. The Department is also involved in training key functionaries and teachers and conducting researches in vocational education. The strategy for the future is to promote vocational courses for sustainable agriculture such as organic farming, vermicompost production etc., and improvement in production, processing and quality of food.

#### 2. Business and Commerce

The Department of Business and Commerce was established for developing guidelines, curricula and teaching-learning materials for the vocational education in various related sectors, such as retail, logistics, banking, financial services and insurance. Over the years, the department has developed the credibility of designing and developing courses and conducting training programs for vocational teachers.

#### 3. Engineering and Technology

The Department of Engineering and Technology was established with the objective of designing and implementing programs and activities for research, development of guidelines, curricula and teaching-learning materials for vocational courses related to various sectors, including Automotive, Electronics, Information Technology, IT-enabled Services, Power, etc. Besides research and development inputs, the Department conducts training sessions on the use and applications of Information and Communication Technology.

#### 4. Health and Paramedical Sciences

The Department of Health and Paramedical Sciences is contributing to the development of highquality middle level skilled manpower in health sector. The department strives for innovation and continuous improvement in the quality and relevance of the training programs and activities for the development of curricula and teaching-learning materials in healthcare sector.

#### 5. Home Science and Hospitality Management

The Department of Home Science and Hospitality has established its identity by organizing programs and activities for development of curricula and courseware and conducting orientation and training programs for the teachers and instructors teaching home science based vocational courses. It has developed courses for a wide variety of services in different sectors, including Apparel, Textiles, Tourism and Hospitality, etc.

#### 6. Humanities, Science, Education and Research

The Department of Humanities, Science and Education Research, having a wider ambit, provides research and development inputs for guiding the process of development of curricula, courseware and other materials in areas like performing arts, commercial art, entrepreneurship development, rural development, etc.

#### 7. Programme Planning and Monitoring Centre

The Centre coordinates the process of programme formulation, monitoring, evaluation and submitting periodic reports to NCERT. It works for the implementation of all the programmes approved by the Programme Advisory Committee (PAC). It also coordinates with the Programme Monitoring Division of NCERT.

#### 8. Curriculum Development and Evaluation Centre

The Centre coordinates the activities of development, evaluation and vetting of curricula and courseware for vocational subjects under the National Skill Qualification Framework (NSQF).

#### 9. Centre for International Relations

The Centre for International Relations contributes to the international networking and development of relations with various international institutions or organizations for academic exchange.

#### 10. Information and Communication Technology (ICT) Centre

The Institute has established an ICT Centre with the aim and objective to design and develop digital resources or E-content of the new job roles developed by PSSCIVE. The ICT Centre also provides their services (photography and videography) during different development and training programme of the Institute. The establishment of acoustic E-studio is also in progress with all state of art facilities required for audio and video recording. Apart from this, ICT Centre also looking and supervising the Intranet, Internet and Wi-Fi facilities of the Institute and providing technical guidance and support as and when required. At present, the equipment available in the ICT Centre are HP Desktop Computers - i5, HP Pro-Liant Workstation, HP Desktop Computer - i3 with Podium and other Accessories (Interactive Panel, Cordless Mike, Collar Mike, etc.), LED TV 70 inch, HP LaserJet Colour Printer, White Smart Board, Sony Camcorder Video Camera, Panasonic Video Camera, Digital Still Camera, Tascam Audio Recorder, Sennheiser Wireless Microphone System, Tripod for Video Camera, Halogen Light, Photo Studio Light, External HDD 4 TB, External HDD 2 TB, Multimedia Projector, Handy Cam, IBM Server, Multimedia Speaker 4.1 channel, Visualizer, White Writing Board.

The ICT includes a Computer Centre established in 1993. Since its inception, it is consistently creating its place of excellence within the institute and NCERT. Initially the Computer Centre has Unix Server with terminals. With the advancement in development of computer technology, the institute has established a Computer Centre in its new campus at Shyamla Hills, Bhopal. At present, the Centre has 50 computers with latest configuration and a Server. All computers are provided with internet connection. This is the central facility of the institute and can be used by any faculty, staff, and project fellows of the institute. These computers are used for developing graphics and video editing by the project staff. They are also being used by the trainees of Diploma in Vocational Education and Training and the participants of various training programme for completing their assignment and projects during the programmes conducted by the institute.

### **Achievements of PSSCIVE**

- Development of Curriculum and Textbooks: The institute has developed Curriculum for 152 job roles in last two years. Till date 69 textbooks in 19 job sectors have been published and many are in the process of editing and will be published soon.
- Development of Digital Resources for Vocational and Pre-Vocational Education: The Institute has developed 500 slide presentations, 200 video films related to the domain-specific skills and 35 videos for pre-vocational activities. Students have access to textbooks, e-content, videos, practice sessions and self-check exercises, etc. for various vocational subjects on DIKSHA (Digital Infrastructure for School Education) platform.
- Development of Guidelines: The Institute has developed Guideline and Modules for Pre-vocational Education, 10 Bagless Days in Schools for Classes VI to VIII, A module on Fun-based Learning Activities, Draft Guideline for Optimal Utilization of Unused Capacity of Schools and Draft Guidelines on Implementation of Hub and Spoke Model of Skilling.
- Development of Online Vocational Interest Inventory instrument: An Online Vocational Interest Inventory instrument has been developed by a group of experts at PSSCIVE to help students identify their interests and the fields that match them. The inventory comprises items to be answered by the students of Grade 8 in terms of likes and dislikes for certain tasks or activities, which will help them to know their vocational interests and choose the vocation of their interest. Teachers and Counsellors can utilize the outcomes of the inventory to guide the students and to help them to choose their career path or vocation.
- National Meeting-cum-Workshop for Alignment of Vocational Education from Higher Secondary Education to Higher Education: During 2022-23, the Institute conducted a National Meeting-cum-Workshop for Alignment of Vocational Education from Higher Secondary Education to Higher Education. The meeting was attended by more than 500 participants including TVET administrators, policymakers, officials from various departments, researchers, academic professionals, representatives and experts from various Sector Skill Councils and national organizations, teachers, vocational trainers and other stakeholders.
- National Consultation Meeting-cum-Workshop for Implementation of Vocational Education in Schools under Samagra Shiksha for the States: The National Consultation Meeting-cum-workshop for Implementation of Vocational Education in Schools under Samagra Shiksha was organised at PSSCIVE, Bhopal from 27 to 28 February, 2023. The meeting was attended by 49 participants including State Officials of Directorate of School Education, Directorate of Vocational Education and Training, State Council of Educational Research and Training, Central and State boards, NGOs, etc.
- Orientation Programme of Key Functionaries on NEP 2020 to Strengthen Vocational Education and Training in Schools: During 2022-23, the institute organized 09 orientation programmes for the states of Uttarakhand, Uttar Pradesh, Madhya Pradesh, Chhattisgarh, Rajasthan, Bihar, West Bengal, North Eastern States, Gujarat, Maharashtra, Goa, Karnataka, Kerala, Tamil Nadu, Puducherry, Andhra Pradesh, Telangana, Odisha including one programme for Minority Institutions. In total, 532 key functionaries attended these programmes and benefitted.

- Capacity Building Programme for Teachers on Employability skills for Vocational Education: The Institute organises Capacity building programme for teachers on Employability Skills for vocational education for different regions of the country including North-eastern region. During the year 2022-23, the institute organized 04 capacity building programmes. Total 124 teachers attended the programmes and got benefitted.
- Training programmes for developing Master Trainers on Vocational Pedagogy: During 2022-23, the institute organized 10 training programmes for developing Master trainers on vocational pedagogy for the states of Uttarakhand, Uttar Pradesh, Madhya Pradesh, Chhattisgarh, Rajasthan, Bihar, West Bengal, North Eastern States, Gujarat, Maharashtra, Goa, Karnataka, Kerala, Tamil Nadu, Puducherry, Andhra Pradesh, Telangana, Odisha, Andaman & Nicobar Islands, Jammu & Kashmir and Lakshadweep. In total, 777 Teachers attended these programmes and got benefitted.
- Teachers Training on Different Vocational Subjects (Job Roles) Implemented under Samagra Shiksha: During 2022-23, the institute organized 06 training programmes for teachers of Job roles Automobile Technology, Animator & Texturing Artist, Apparel Made Ups and Home Furnishing, Retail, Health Care and two programmes for job roles of Agriculture sector. Total 187 teachers participated in these programmes and were acquainted with the latest technology and trends in the area of the concerned job roles of different sectors
- Innovative Model of Vocational Education in Schools: The Institute has taken up a project on Innovative Model of Vocational Education in Schools approved by the Samagra Shiksha Project Approval Board (PAB). Under this, Four Demonstration Multipurpose Schools (DMSs) of NCERT located in Ajmer, Bhopal, Bhubaneshwar and Mysuru and six schools affiliated to the State Boards of Madhya Pradesh, Tripura, Meghalaya, Rajasthan, Karnataka and Odisha have been included in the project. In Grades 9 to 12, specialised skills are being imparted to students in various sectors like Agriculture, Automotive, Beauty and Wellness, Electronics and Hardware, Information Technology IT enabled Services, Retail and Tourism and Hospitality.
- Diploma in Vocational Education and Training (DVET): The Institute has started Diploma in Vocational Education and Training programme in distance mode. The first batch graduated this year and 40 Students from all over the country were awarded the Diploma on 21<sup>st</sup> January, 2022 in an online graduation ceremony.
- Virtual Skill Labs: In order to address the need to scale the availability of quality vocational education through online content and tools, the Ministry of Education (MoE) has entrusted the task of developing Virtual Skill Labs to PSSCIVE. In total, 75 Virtual Skill Labs for vocational courses in 10 sectors are in the process of development. These Virtual Skill Labs is a virtual environment that allows a student to perform activities through simulation, 3D animations, videos, etc. and pick up key components of a particular skill.
- Awards: The Institute has been felicitated with the "Green Skills Award 2021" by the European Training Foundation (ETF), Italy and "Innovative Trainers Award 2022" by Indian Society for Training & Development, New Delhi.


